Please read through all of the enclosed information which will guide you in nominating your horse for the 2019 Fall Classic Breeders' Sale. The sale will break from tradition this year and will be held one week prior to Thanksgiving.

Eligible nominations must include:

- Completed Nomination Form (print or web) signed by the registered owner(s) of the horse
- Scan of the horse's registration certificate (original paper copy to be provided at sale check-in).
- Catalogue notes submitted electronically for the nominated horse, sire, and dam.
- Left side full body profile photograph of horse.
- Fees for each horse nominated as a separate cheque or individual email transfer. Nominations not paid in full will be placed on a wait-list.

In an effort to improve communications, we will be sending regular notices by e-mail. Please provide an e-mail address and check your e-mail frequently.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT THIS PACKAGE

FAQs

1) How do I determine if my horse is eligible for the sale?

Read through the *Basic Eligibility and Limiting Criteria*. If you have questions, please contact the Sale Administrator (403) 630-2551, prior to submitting your nomination.

2) Do I have to submit the original registration papers?

Yes. Original registration papers must be provided to the sale office on or before Thursday, October 3. For young horses with pending registration, a copy of the application is required.

3) What is the deadline for nominations?

Thursday, July 25.

4) When do you require the catalogue notes?

By the nomination deadline submitted electronically.

I'VE SENT IN MY NOMINATION(S), WHAT HAPPENS NEXT?

- You will be notified of the status of your nomination(s) on or before **July 31** - selected, wait-listed or not selected.
- **Three photos must be submitted by Aug 1.** For all riding horses, at least one photo under saddle is recommended. The sale committee reserves the right to refuse any photograph deemed to be of insufficient quality. Submit files by e-mail in a JPEG format to admin@fallclassicsale.com.
- **A video link must be submitted by Aug 1.** Please email the Youtube link or other internet video location to admin@fallclassicsale.com. One video link per horse.
- You will receive a **Consignor's package** with further instructions by September 27. **CAREFULLY** read the contents of the package as there will be important information included and a number of preparations required for participation in the sale.
- Ensure your horse has a current negative Coggins Test for EIA (and meets all veterinary requirements as laid out in the Terms and Conditions. (i.e. - x-rays, vaccinations, pregnancy checks, etc. as required.) A copy of the test for EIA test must be sent to the office prior to the a horse's arrival at the sale site.

TERMS, CONDITIONS & GOVERNING POLICY

I. BASIC ELIGIBILITY

- 1) Horses eligible for nomination must be registered Canadian Warmblood or with another recognized Warmblood registry (as in I.1 and I.2 below), and
 - a) the offspring of a Stallion licensed or approved by a recognized Warmblood registry **AND**;
 - b) the offspring of a Mare inspected by a recognized Warmblood registry **AND**;
 - c) have Warmblood pedigree content as recognized by the CWHBA Articles of Incorporation or, in the case of Thoroughbred, Arab, or Anglo-Arab, be a:
 - i) Mare inspected and entered into the CWHBA Stud Book and confirmed to be in foal by a stallion that is licensed or approved by the CWHBA.
 - ii) Stallion that has been inspected and entered in the CWHBA Stud Book.

I.2 Providing horses meet CWHBA standards for warmblood registration:

Canadian Sport Horse Rheinland-Pfalz-Saar



- 2) Priority will be given to Canadian-born horses but a **limited number of imports** will be permitted at the discretion of the sale committee with proof of Canadian ownership



- 3) Prospects Under Saddle must be **6 years of age or under** as of the date of the sale.



- 4) Performance Horses must be **12 years of age** or under as of the date of the sale.

- 5) Horses nominated to the Performance Horse category must have shown at a minimum of one EC-rated show and must have a passport.

- 6) Broodmares must:

- a) be 15 years of age or under as of the date of the sale **AND**;
- b) have been bred in the sale year to an approved warmblood stallion as per CWHBA standards of pedigree **AND**;
- c) meet the same soundness requirements as Performance Horses (with the exception of ET surrogates); **AND**
- d) meet breed eligibility requirements (including inspection); **AND**
- e) have pregnancy confirmed within 10 days of the date of the sale.

- 7) Embryo Transfer (ET) surrogate mares must;

- a) have pregnancy confirmed 90 days prior to sale date and within 10 days of the date of the sale.
- b) Dam and Sire must be approved for breeding by either CWHBA or another approved registry, DNA must be on file with this registry. An Embryo Transfer of Ownership Application for sale of embryos and a breeding certificate must accompany the nomination form.

- 8) Consignor must be a member in good standing of the CWHBA. Non-members must have a current regular or associate membership at the time of the sale. Visit www.canadianwarmbloods.com for information on membership.

II. LIMITING CRITERIA



- 1) **45 lots** will be accepted for the sale.
- 2) All nomination forms and required documentation must be complete and include all required enclosures listed on the nomination form checklist. This includes payment of all fees, a copy of the registration papers, and the notes for the nominated horse, its sire, and its dam. Incomplete nominations will be placed on a wait list.
- 3) If more than 45 complete nominations meeting the basic eligibility of the sale are received by the nomination deadline, the Selection Committee may apply the following established discretionary guidelines to all nominations received:
 - a) Preference may be given to Canadian Warmblood registered horses.
 - b) Past consignors may be given preference.
 - c) The dam's inspection scores and/or show records may be considered.
 - d) Alberta consignors with multiple nominations may be limited to three entries per owner.
 - e) Out of province consignors may be limited to two entries per owner.

III. NOMINATIONS

- 1) All owners agree that by nominating their horse(s) they will allow their horse(s) to be tested according to the Equine Canada Medications Control Committee.
- 2) All nominations must include a scan of the horse's original registration certificate showing the name of the owner(s) nominating the horse. *If registration is pending then a copy of the registration application is required.
- 3) Where the owner of a horse is a partnership, limited company, ranch, or farm, all legal signatories must sign the nomination form.
- 4) All information and representations are the sole responsibility, and made on behalf of, the seller.
- 5) The seller warrants that each horse consigned is free and clear of all liens and encumbrances.
- 6) Nomination form, registration papers, notes, photo and cheque or email transfer must be received no later than:
 - a) July 25, 2019 for catalogued horses. Fees will be deposited when horses have been approved for the sale.
 - b) September 27, 2019 for late additions or substitutions (accepted only if space permits).

IV. FEES, COMMISSIONS, WITHDRAWALS, DISBURSEMENTS

NOMINATION FEES

- 1) Nomination Fees for CWHBA Registered or Entered & Inspected:
 - a) Weanlings and Yearlings \$470.00
 - b) Horses 2 years of age and over \$470.00
 - c) Package Offerings (Mare & Foal or Pregnant Mare & Foal)..... \$470.00
 - d) Embryo Transfer Packages (Pregnant Surrogate Mare) \$470.00
- 2) For Eligible Horses Registered OTHER than CWHBA registered or entered & inspected (ET Surrogates exempt):
 - a) To the above nomination fee (1) ADD..... \$300.00
- 3) For Late Additions (after July 31):
 - a) To the above nomination fee (1) ADD..... \$100.00
- 4) For Veterinary Substitutions..... \$100.00

SELLING COMMISSION

A commission will be charged on each horse sold at the following rates:

10% on first \$25,000
7.5% from \$25,001 to \$30,000
5.0% on balance over \$30,000

BUY-BACK FEES

A buy-back fee of \$500 or 10%, whichever is the lesser, will be charged on horses not sold. No fees will be charged on horses who do not reach the minimum bid for their category. Minimum bids are as follows:

Broodmares, foals and yearlings	\$3,000
Embryo Transfers	\$3,000
2-Year-Olds	\$3,000
Prospects Under Saddle	\$6,000
Performance Horses	\$6,000

Horses not sold will not be permitted to leave the sale grounds, nor will registration papers be returned, until buy-back fees are paid in full. All horses (sold or not) are expected to be removed from the sale grounds by noon on October 6, 2019.

WITHDRAWALS


- 1) A **withdrawal** of any catalogued horse will result in forfeiture of the nomination fee. Stabling fees will be refunded for horses withdrawn prior to September 30, with the exception of presold horses.
- 2) **Veterinary withdrawals** prior to cataloguing (July 31), will receive a full refund less a \$100.00 administration charge. Veterinary withdrawals after July 31 will forfeit the nomination fee but are open to substitution (see item 3). All veterinary withdrawals must be verified with a written veterinary certificate.
- 3) **Substitutions** are considered only in the event of a veterinary withdrawal and are subject to a \$100 fee.
- 4) **Pre-sale** of a catalogued horse will result in ALL FEES being forfeited plus a penalty calculated at 10% of the two-year average for the applicable sale category. Pre-selling may impact future participation in the Fall Classic Breeders Sale.

FINAL DISBURSEMENTS

- 1) CWHBA - Alberta Chapter acts only as a clearing house for funds collected for and on behalf of the seller.
- 2) GST is collected for and on behalf of the seller **ONLY** when the seller provides a GST registration number.
- 3) Consignor's accounts will be settled when the bank hold has been released from the purchaser's funds.
- 4) Purchaser's funds are held based on the location of origin of the funds as follows;
 - a) 7 days within province
 - b) 10 days out of province
 - c) 21 days out of country
- 5) Each consignor will be issued a single cheque to settle the account.
- 6) For multiple consignments, settlement will occur when final purchaser funds are released.


V. HEALTH & SOUNDNESS REQUIREMENTS, REGULATIONS, WAIVER OF LIABILITY

VETERINARY & SOUNDNESS REQUIREMENTS

- 1) Each nominated horse is required to successfully undergo a pre-sale examination by a Sale Veterinarian, who will perform an insurance equivalent physical exam including musculoskeletal, eye, respiratory and heart.
- 2) All horses will be evaluated by the Soundness Committee for soundness, body condition, and conformation. The sale is unable to get good prices for horses with visible defects.
- 3) Pregnant mares and Embryo Transfer surrogate mares must have a proof of pregnancy check within 10 days of the sale.
- 4) Horses that have been refused by the Soundness Committee will have a "withdrawn" sign placed on their stall and all other sale signage removed. Alternatively, horses can be removed from the sale grounds.
- 5) Refused horses may be re-evaluated at the discretion of the Soundness Committee.
- 6) All sale horses must have current vaccinations (age appropriate) for E and W Encephalitis, Tetanus, Flu, Rhinopneumonitis and West Nile. Horses must be vaccinated at least 14 days prior to sale.
- 7) Pregnant mares must have current Pneumabort/Prodigy vaccinations determined by the date at which the mare was bred.
- 8) Verification of all vaccinations must be presented at the pre-sale veterinary inspection. For those vaccines self-administered, a receipt for the purchase of your vaccines is adequate.
- 9) X-rays are required for all Performance Horses and Prospects aged three and over. In response to requests for 2-Year-Old x-rays in recent years, x-rays for this category are recommended but not required. X-rays must be no more than 6 months old and must clearly indicate the date they were taken and the horse's registered name. The required x-ray views (See Appendix A - X-ray Information) must be emailed to the sale administrator by your veterinarian at least two weeks prior to the sale, by Thursday, September 19. **A \$65 per horse x-ray evaluation fee will be due at the sale to cover the cost of the University of Calgary radiologist. These fees will allow potential buyers to view x-rays at no charge.**
- 10)  A valid, negative EIA (Coggins) test for Equine Infectious Anemia is required for ALL sale horses. The registered name **MUST** be on the test. **A copy of the test must be emailed to the sale office prior to the horse arriving at the sale grounds. Any horse without a negative coggins will not be permitted on site.**

REGULATIONS

- 1) The Sale Committee reserves the right to refuse or withdraw any horse from the sale without refund or liability to anyone.
- 2) Transfers for ALL horses **MUST** be signed prior to the start of the sale and have the appropriate payment by cheque attached (no cash please). Horses without a signed transfer and payment for said transfer will not be sold.
- 3) A shipping manifest from the province of origin is required for all horses being sold at auction (one manifest per vehicle). Manifests are to be completed upon your departure from home and copies brought to the sale office when checking in.
- 4) All horses must be prepared to participate in the demonstrations and other scheduled events.
- 5) Riders are to be dressed in show turnout for the sale. ALL horses must be pulled and braided beginning Friday morning. When showing in hand, handlers must be attired in dark green tops and black pants. For all riding demonstrations riders are to be in dark green tops, breeches, boots and helmets. Embryo Transfer mares will be shown in a specific cooler provided prior to entering the arena.

Helmets are mandatory and must be worn by anyone riding a horse anywhere on the sale grounds.
- 6) Any horse to be shown through the free chute must attend the chute jumping practice on Thursday, October 3.
- 7)  Weanling-age foals offered for sale may be shown at the foot of their dam. Consignors of foals to be shown with their dam are asked to indicate such by making note on the nomination forms and **providing a weaning date/release date of foal or mare.**

REGULATIONS *continued...*

- 8) All horses will be listed in the catalogue and on all administration papers with their registered names.
- 9) Consignors are required to have stalls cleaned by 9:30 a.m. each morning and must keep stall front areas clean.
- 10) Reserved bids are permitted and can be placed with the auction staff by completing a "Reserve Bid" form in the sale office. Bids can be changed as late as five lots prior to your horse entering the sale ring.
- 11) Each horse will be sold to the highest bidder as determined by the auctioneer. The auctioneer's decision is FINAL and, along with the sale staff, the auctioneer acts as agent for the seller but assumes no responsibility for the buyer or the seller.
- 12) All horses are sold as is. Right of recourse must be directed to the seller and not to CWHBA or sale management.
- 13) All horses sold must be delivered to the new owner with a halter.
- 14) Upon the auctioneer declaring the horse as sold, all risk, title, care and responsibility shall pass to the buyer.
- 15) All horses (sold or not) are expected to be removed from the sale grounds by noon on Sunday, October 6, 2019.
