Sire: WHIRLWIND II started winning futurities and championships in dressage, jumper, and hunter at 4 years old. In 2011 he produced a double clear at 1.20m to help his team win the Team Cup, then finished off the year winning A Hunter in the Mid-West in classics and derbies. His sire HAARLEM was a strong international jumper by the ever-famous VOLTAIRE, long in the top ten sires of FEI horses. His dam SOPHIE (show name Seniorita) has won in the 1.40m and 1.45m. His granddam, IMALVE produced Mexican Olympic team horse DON POROFINO. His grandsire EKSTEIN is the dam sire of world and Olympic champion HICKSTEAD. WHIRLWIND has produced futurity champion foals, Material Class champions and now that they are old enough to ride, champions in the hunter and dressage ring, and serious winners in the jumper ring.

Dam: MJ BACCARAT (Betty) had been well started and was ready for a career in the hunter ring when a minor paddock accident slowed progress. To allow healing time, she was bred in 2009 and produced MJ BELLAGIO in 2010. Betty was a beautiful hunter type mare with a long step and expressive jump. Her sire FANTAST, a paternal half-brother to the immortal BIG BEN has produced many top hunter, Grand Prix jumper and FEI dressage winners. His pedigree includes many of the foundation horses of modern show jumping including FEI rated sires ETRETAT, IBRAHIM, and NITTARD.

Notes: ROMEO was purchased 6 years ago from the Fall Classic Sale for my then 10 year old daughter. Since then he was predominantly used in show jumping up to 3'3, but has also been involved in dressage, cross country jumping, eventing, trail riding, and used in 4H for 3 years. Last year he was shown in the hunter ring at RMSJ and did very well. "Ro" is a stunning boy that gets noticed and has a slow, lofty canter so we feel he is better suited as a hunter, or dressage horse. Romeo is easy to catch in a field and likes his people. He does have a bit of a goofy nature and likes to take blankets off of other horses. He is an easy keeper and is good to tie, trailer, stable, vaccinate, farrier, haul, clip and bathe. He has patience for banding up until the last 5 or so, but we just started that last year so there's room for improvement. Romeo is best suited for an intermediate rider.
