



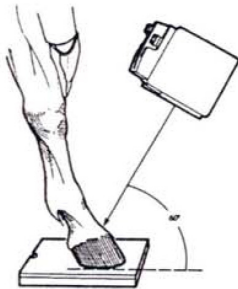

SALE SELECTIONS - VETERINARY & SOUNDNESS REQUIREMENTS
- APPENDIX A

- X-RAYS ARE MANDATORY for all Under Saddle Prospects and Performance Horses age 3 years and over and optional for all other horses.
- X-rays must be no more than 6 months old and must clearly indicate the date they were taken and the horse's registered name (no barn names please).
- The required x-ray views must be emailed to the sale office (admin@fallclassicsale.com) by your veterinarian at least two weeks prior to the sale, by Thursday, September 21. DICOM files are preferred over JPG files.

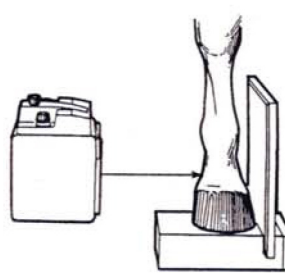
X-RAY #1



Navicular and distal phalynx of both front feet
60° Dorsoproximal - Palmarodistal view

- the foot must be thoroughly cleaned and packed with Play-doh or other suitable packing
- the shoe should be removed

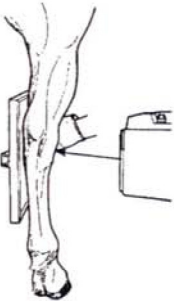
X-RAY #2



Navicular, pastern, fetlock & sesamoids of both front legs
Lateromedial view (foot, pastern & fetlock)

- taken with the foot on a 2" block and using a 11"x14" cassette
- the x-ray beam is centered mid-pastern and the view must include the entire coffin bone, hoof wall, pastern, fetlock and sesamoids

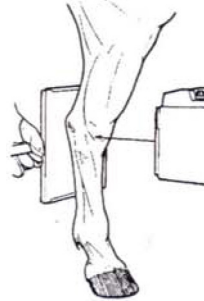
X-RAY #3



Tarsus
Lateromedial view of the left and right hock

- taken at 20° plantar lateral to dorsomedial from a true lateral
- this view is closer to a lateral view than a lateral oblique

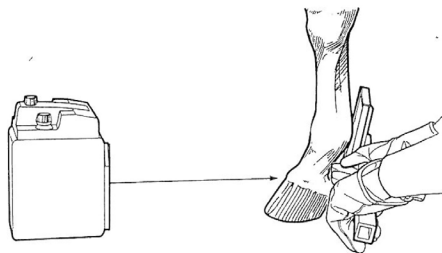
X-RAY #4



Tarsus
Dorsolateral-plantaromedial oblique view of the left and right hock

- this view taken 30° lateral to a true dorsoplantar (or AP) view

X-RAY #5



Fetlock, pastern & coffin of both front legs
Horizontal Dorsoproximal – Palmarodistal view

- the x-ray beam is centered at the coronary band and must include the pastern joint, coffin bone, and fetlock.
- also known as an AP view or standing DP
